The Center for Social Science Innovation (CSSI) is the University of Iowa's central hub for social scientists including faculty, staff, and PhD students.



Workshops

CSSI delivered fifteen workshops on research design, advanced methodologies, and peer review to over one hundred UI faculty, staff, and students.
